

Work Experience – Grounds and Maintenance

What do we offer?

Work experience students will spend a total of five days at the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust in the Grounds and Maintenance program. Students will rotate between both the grounds and maintenance teams providing an insight into how the department contributes to the vision and business goals of the Trust.

We receive a large number of applications for this program every year and as a result of the high demand aren't always able to accommodate everyone. Applications will be assessed against the time of requested work and suitability for the placement.

The team

The Grounds and Maintenance team at the Sydney Cricket and Sports Ground Trust have the responsibility and privilege of looking after Australia's premier sporting venue, the Sydney Cricket Ground. The main responsibilities of the team are listed below; these are things that students may be exposed to during their placement.

- Preparation of playing surfaces
- Preparation of the outfield, training field and practice wickets
- Changeover of fields for different events and sporting codes
- Testing of the hardness of the playing field
- Landscaping and gardening
- Maintenance of the surrounding lawns and gardens
- Maintenance of equipment and buildings
- Purchasing of tools and equipment
- Preventative maintenance checks before events
