## **Singapore Cricket Club (SCC)**

Established in 1852, the Singapore Cricket Club is today is one of the leading Sports and Social Clubs in Asia. The SCC is the second oldest Sports Club in Singapore, junior by 10 years to the Singapore Sporting Club, now the Singapore Turf Club. The Club stands at the centre of the city's old colonial heart, a public space that has witnessed many of Singapore's triumphs and defeats, upheavals, independence and, finally, the annual National Day Parades on 9 August annually.

## **Location**

Nearby historic buildings include Raffles Hotel, St Andrew's Cathedral, City Hall (on the steps of which the Japanese surrendered to the British in 1945), the Old Supreme Court, the renovated National Art Gallery of Singapore, Old Parliament House (now the Arts House), Victoria Theatre and Memorial Hall, and Empress Place Building (formerly government offices and now the Asian Civilisations Museum).

## **Club Hours**

### Club

## Squash and Tennis Courts

Monday to Sunday, Eve of Public Holiday and Public Holiday - 7:00 am to 10.00 pm

Subject to such conditions as the Committee may from time to time decide.

(a) The Management may, having regard to the prevailing circumstances, extend the closing time of one or more bars in the Club to such time or times as it shall in its sole discretion decide.

## **Dress code**

(a) Members and guests must be appropriately attired when visiting the Club and using its facilities. The accepted attire is shirts which must have collars and sleeves and trousers; or national costumes. Neck-tie is not essential. Except as provided otherwise in this bye-law:-

(i) No flip flops, open-toe footwear (for men), sandals, clogs, singlets, shorts, bermudas and collarless tee-shirts are permitted in the Club.

(ii) Clothes which are torn, ripped (whether for fashion or otherwise) or soiled, overalls, boilersuits and combat clothing are not allowed. Singapore Armed Forces (SAF) personnel in Uniform (Number 1, 2, 3 and 4) and Foreign Military Service Personnel in conformity are allowed.

(b) Headgear shall not be worn within the Club other than for medical or religious reasons.

(c) Persons still wearing the attire in which they have played any sport shall not enter any of the air-conditioned areas of the Club, except the Changing Rooms.

(d) **Oval:** Bermudas and dress shorts are permitted on weekends and public holidays.

(e) **Oval Verandah:** Bermudas are permitted. Dress shorts are only permitted on weekends and public holidays.

(f) **Sports Verandah:** Bermudas, shorts and all footwear are permitted.

(g) **Men's Bar:** Shorts, bermudas and collarless tee-shirts are permitted.

(h) **Stumps Bar and Terrace:** Shorts, bermudas, and collarless tee-shirts are permitted.

(i) **The Victoria Room:** Bermudas and dress shorts are permitted on weekends and public holidays.
