Members have the privilege of exclusive seating arrangements and facilities within the stadium. In order to take advantage of Eden Park's events you must be a full member of one of the following stadiums.



## Corporate Lounge Access (North Stand Level 5)

Tickets in this area give members access to the exclusive lounge during all fixtures at Eden Park, in which you can order world-class dining and hospitality, or take a more informal approach with our casual offerings. Seats are located directly outside the lounge, and represent a brilliant place to take in the atmosphere. If there is inclement weather however, the lounge does have four 4.8-by-2.8 metre TV screens - great for watching replays! There is a smart-casual dress code in this area.

## Stadium Bowl Seats

Alternatively, seats are available on Level 4 of the North Stand and Level 6 of the South Stand within the stadium bowl. These seats are located directly on the half way line, giving the spectator the best possible position and outlook of the event. This option provides great seats and allows the freedom to purchase food and beverages from the many retail outlets throughout the stadium.

There are limited seats available in both these areas and cannot be purchased by members of the general public.

NEW ZEALAND'S NATIONAL STADIUM

## General

- All patrons entering the stadium do so at their own risk
- All patrons entering the stadium must occupy the seat that they have been allocated
- Umbrellas may not be raised within the stadium
- There shall be no unsolicited selling of merchandise, advertising or promotional giveaways
- Liquor will not be served to minors or intoxicated persons and no patron may remove liquor from the stadium
- Children under the age of 14 years must be supervised by an adult at all times
- At all times patrons must comply with the instructions of security staff
- Reciprocal Purchase available for all Eden Park fixtures (subject to availability)

## Dress requirements

A smart standard of dress is required at all times within the corporate facilities. If however a member or non-member is dressed inappropriately, management or security will refuse the right of entry.
